HOUSE BILL 1068

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ANY ACTIVE, INACTIVE OR RETIRED MEMBER OF THE ARKANSAS NATIONAL GUARD AND ANY ACTIVE, INACTIVE OR RETIRED MEMBER OR VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES WHO IS A RESIDENT OF ARKANSAS AND WHO IS NOT OTHERWISE ENTITLED TO OBTAIN A SPECIAL MILITARY LICENSE PLATE FOR HIS OR HER PERSONAL VEHICLE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO OBTAIN A SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE FOR HIS OR HER PERSONAL VEHICLE; TO PRESCRIBE THE PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING A SPECIAL MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Any active, inactive or retired member of the Arkansas National Guard and any active, inactive or retired member or veteran of the armed forces of the United States who is a resident of Arkansas and who is not otherwise entitled by law to obtain a special military license plate for his or her personal vehicle shall be entitled to obtain such special license plate in the manner herein prescribed.

SECTION 2. Any person desiring to obtain a special motor vehicle license plate as authorized in this Act shall upon making application therefor to the Commissioner of Revenues furnish proof of the applicant's military status, comply with all State laws relating to the registration of motor vehicles, and pay the regular registration fee for the vehicle sought to be registered plus one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) to defray the cost of production of the special license plate.

SECTION 3. License plates issued pursuant to this Act shall be so

designed as to indicate the military affiliation and status of the owner of the vehicle for which the license plate is issued.

SECTION 4. The Commissioner of Revenues shall adopt appropriate rules and regulations to carry out the purpose and intent of this Act and to prevent abuse thereof.

SECTION 5. The provisions of this Act shall be supplemental to and shall not repeal any other laws relating to the issuance of special license plates for military personnel.
