HOUSE BILL 1075

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS STATUTE 19-1031 TO PERMIT CITY CLERKS AND CLERK-TREASURERS TO RETIRE AT AGE 60 AFTER 10 OR MORE YEARS OF SERVICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 313 of 1957, as amended (Ark. Stat. 19-1031) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Any city clerk or clerk-treasurer in a city of the first class who shall have served as city clerk, clerk-treasurer and city treasurer for a period of not less than ten (10) years, upon reaching age sixty (60) or who shall serve twenty (20) years without regard to age shall be entitled to retire from office for the remainder of his or her life at the retirement pay provided for in Section 2 of Act 313 of 1957, as amended."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
