HOUSE BILL 1087

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION SHALL RECEIVE \$100.00 PER DIEM PLUS EXPENSES IN LIEU OF SALARY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Hereafter no member of the Arkansas Transportation Commission shall receive a salary for compensation for service on the Commission, but in lieu thereof shall receive \$100.00 per diem and actual expenses while engaged in the work of the Commission. No State-owned motor vehicle shall be assigned to any member of the Arkansas Transportation Commission.

SECTION 2. Items (1) and (2) of Section 1 of Act 49 of 1985 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the laws applicable to the Arkansas Transportation Commission are different from those applicable to similar State commissions; that until the Transportation Commission is treated in the same manner as similar commissions the resources of the State will not be most effectively and efficiently administered; that this Act will provide equal treatment for the Transportation Commission in light of laws applicable to similar commissions; and that until this Act becomes effective such equality of treatment will not exist. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
