"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ACT 294 OF 1975 TO PROVIDE THAT
THE JUDGE OF THE MOUNTAIN VIEW MUNICIPAL COURT SHALL BE
ELECTED BY THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF STONE COUNTY; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act 294 of 1975 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The judge of the Mountain View Municipal Court shall be elected by the qualified electors of Stone County, Arkansas, at the 1988 General Election and each four (4) years thereafter for a term of four (4) years, and shall serve for such term and until his successor is elected and qualified. Provided, however, that the municipal judge elected to said court in the general election held in 1984, and now serving shall serve as judge of such court until his successor is elected and qualified at the 1988 General Election. The judge of said court shall be nominated and elected in the same manner now provided by or as may hereafter be provided by law for the nomination and election of elected county officials of Stone County, Arkansas." Provided, when any vacancy is filled at a special election occurring prior to the 1988 general election, the candidate shall be elected only by the electors of the City of Mountain View.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
