HOUSE BILL 1121

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT MOTOR VEHICLES DESIGNED AND USED FOR TRANSPORTING SOLID WASTE SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO THE STATE AXLE WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS ON PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN THIS STATE WHEN TRANSPORTING SOLID WASTE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, motor vehicles designed and used for transporting solid waste are not subject to the axle weight restrictions prescribed by State law when the motor vehicles are transporting solid waste on the public streets and highways of this State. Provided, however, that nothing in this Act shall affect the gross weight restrictions for such vehicles prescribed by State law nor shall the provisions of this Act apply to the national system of interstate and defense highways if its application would cause the State to lose any federal highway moneys.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
