HOUSE BILL 1122

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT PERSONS REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN AN ALPHABETICAL LIST OF BAIL BOND MEN AND BAIL BOND COMPANIES UNDER ARKANSAS STATUTE 43-743 SHALL MONTHLY RECOMPILE THE LIST SO THAT EACH MONTH THE NAME THAT WAS THE FIRST ON THE LIST THE PRIOR MONTH WILL BE ROTATED TO THE BOTTOM OF THE LIST; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Everyone required by Section 10 of Act 400 of 1971 (Ark. Stat. 43-743) to maintain an alphabetical list of currently registered bail bondsmen and professional bail bond companies shall, on the first Monday of each month, recompile the list by rotating the name that was the first name on the list the prior month to the bottom of the list.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that Arkansas Statute 43-743 requires jailers to maintain an alphabetical list of bail bondsmen and make the list available to any prisoner for examination; that equitable treatment dictates that the order of the names on the list be rotated; that this Act would require the rotation of the names on a monthly basis; and that the inequity will prevail until this Act becomes effective. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
