HOUSE BILL 1126

"AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 2 OF ACT 495 OF 1985."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act 495 of 1985 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that Section 2 of Act 495 of 1985 provides that Act 495 will expire on July 1, 1987; the General Assembly further determines that Act 495 should not expire and this Act will result in the repeal of the expiration provision of Act 495; this Act must go into effect prior to July 1, 1987 in order to prevent the expiration of Act 495; and that unless this emergency clause is adopted this Act may not go into effect before July 1, 1987. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
