HOUSE BILL 1132

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6 OF ACT 883 OF 1977 [ARK. STAT. 82-3906] TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON ENGAGED IN COMMERCIAL OR FOR-HIRE HAULING TO OPERATE A VEHICLE TO TRANSPORT THE WASTE PRODUCED FROM THE SLAUGHTER OF ANIMALS UNLESS THE VEHICLE IS COVERED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 6 of Act 883 of 1977, the same being Arkansas Statutes 82-3906, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. It shall be unlawful for any person engaged in commercial or for-hire hauling to operate any truck or other vehicle within this State to transport litter, trash, garbage, or the waste produced from the slaughter of animals unless said vehicle is covered to prevent its contents from blowing, dropping, or falling off or otherwise departing from the vehicle. In addition, any person operating his own truck or other vehicle to transport litter, trash, or garbage shall take reasonable steps to prevent its contents from blowing, dropping, or falling off or otherwise departing from the vehicle. Provided, no vehicle hauling predominately metallic material shall be required to be covered if it is loaded in a manner which will prevent such material from falling or dropping from the vehicle."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
