HOUSE BILL 1184

"AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ANY OFFICER, EMPLOYEE OR AGENT OF A HUMANE SOCIETY OR MUNICIPAL POUND FROM SELLING, GIVING OR OTHERWISE TRANSFERRING POSSESSION OF ANY MAMMAL TO ANY PERSON FOR THE PURPOSE OF LIVE ANIMAL EXPERIMENTATION, RESEARCH OR TESTING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. No officer, employee or agent of any humane society or municipal pound shall sell, give or otherwise transfer custody and possession of any mammal to any person or entity for the ultimate purpose of live animal experimentation, research or testing.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates this Act shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$5,000 or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
