HOUSE BILL 1186

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT COMMERCIAL AND OTHER PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS AND RESIDENTIAL SWIMMING POOLS MAY BE CONSTRUCTED OF FIBERGLASS; TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF VINYL LINERS IN COMMERCIAL AND OTHER PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS AND RESIDENTIAL SWIMMING POOLS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Hereafter, fiberglass swimming pools may be installed and used for commercial or residential purposes and vinyl swimming pool liners may be used in commercial or residential swimming pools, and the State Health Department shall have no authority to prohibit the use of such pools and liners if they meet reasonable health and safety standards.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
