HOUSE BILL 1229

"AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ELECTED OFFICIALS FROM SEEKING ANOTHER ELECTIVE OFFICE WHICH TERM COMMENCES PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF THE TERM OF OFFICE HELD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to promote the public welfare by reducing the number of elective offices vacated by the officeholder prior to the expiration of the office term, thereby reducing the expense involved in special elections, and assuring that public services continue uninterrupted.

SECTION 2. A person holding an elective office of this State or any of its political subdivisions shall not be a candidate for any other elective public office unless the term of the office sought commences after or within thirty (30) days of the expiration of the term of office held.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
