HOUSE BILL 1239

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 20 OF ACT 130 OF 1975 [ARK. STATS. 17-448] AND SECTION 2 OF ACT 193 OF 1937 AS AMENDED [ARK. STATS. 17-712] TO REQUIRE THE COUNTY TREASURER TO MONTHLY SUBMIT TO THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY AND DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT IN WHICH THE COUNTY IS LOCATED A COPY OF THE MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT FILED BY THE TREASURER WITH THE QUORUM COURT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 20 of Act 130 of 1975, the same being Arkansas Statutes 17-448, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 20. The county treasurer shall submit each month to the quorum court and to the prosecuting attorney and deputy prosecuting attorney of the judicial district in which the county is located, a full report and a detailed statement of the financial condition of the county, showing receipts, disbursements, and balance on hand together with all liabilities of the county."

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Act 193 of 1937, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statutes 17-712, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. If any prosecuting attorney or deputy prosecuting attorney in any judicial district of this State fails to enforce the provisions of Amendment No. 10 to the Arkansas Constitution and the application of its terms and conditions to all turnback funds flowing to any county of the State, he shall be liable to impeachment in office. In order that the prosecuting attorney and deputy prosecuting attorney can carry out their duties as prescribed herein, the county treasurer of each county shall monthly file with the prosecuting attorney and deputy prosecuting attorney of the judicial district in which the county is located a copy of the financial report which

the county treasurer is required by law to file with the quorum court of the county. Such report shall include a detailed statement of the financial condition of the county, all receipts and disbursements, and the balance of funds on hand together with all liabilities of the county."

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
