HOUSE BILL 1266

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS STATUTE 19-4616 TO PROVIDE THAT THE HOTEL, MOTEL AND RESTAURANT MEMBERS OF CITY ADVERTISING AND PROMOTION COMMISSIONS MUST BE ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS ON A DAILY BASIS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 5 of Act 185 of 1965, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statute 19-4616, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Any city levying a tax pursuant to this Act shall, in the ordinance levying the tax, create a City Advertising and Promotion Commission, to be composed of seven members as follows: Four members shall be hotel, motel or restaurant owners or managers who are actively engaged in the business on a daily basis, who shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the governing body of the city, for staggered terms of four (4) years; the remaining three members of the Commission shall be the mayor and two members of the governing body of the city selected by the governing body. In the case of cities levying the tax and creating the Commission authorized herein after July 1, 1969, the four hotel, motel or restaurant members appointed by the mayor shall, at the first meeting of the Commission draw lots for terms so that one of such members will serve for a term of one (1) year, one shall serve for a term of two (2) years, one shall serve for a term of three (3) years, and one shall serve for a term of four (4) years, and all successors to such members shall be appointed for terms of four (4) years. In the case of those Commissions which are in existence on July 1, 1969, the terms of all members on such Commissions shall expire on July 1, 1969, and the Commission shall be reconstituted as herein provided and the hotel, motel and restaurant members shall, at the first meeting of the Commission after July 1, 1969 draw lots for terms so that one member will serve for a term of one (1) year, one

member for a term of two (2) years, one member for a term of three (3) years and one member for a term of four (4) years, and their successors shall be appointed for terms of four (4) years."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
