HOUSE BILL 1328

"AN ACT TO AMEND Section 2 OF ACT 241 OF 1959 AS AMENDED,  
[ARK. STAT 67-720] TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO MAKE PAYMENTS  
AGAINST EXISTING ACCOUNTS OR PRE-EXISTING DEBTS WITH A CHECK  
DRAWN ON INSUFFICIENT FUNDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act 241 of 1959 as amended, the same being  
Arkansas Statute 67-720, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to procure any article or  
thing of value, or to secure possession of any personal property to which a  
lien has attached, or to make payment of any taxes, licenses or fees, or any  
fine or court cost, or to make payment against an existing account or a pre-  
existing debt, or for any other purpose to make or draw or utter or deliver,  
with the intent to defraud, any check, draft or order, for the payment of  
money, upon any in-state or out-of-state bank, persons, firm or corporation,  
knowing at the time of such making, drawing, uttering, or delivering, that  
the maker, or drawer, has not sufficient funds in, or on deposit with, such  
bank, person, firm, or corporation for the payment of such check, draft or  
order, in full, and all other checks, drafts or orders upon such funds then  
outstanding."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are  
hereby repealed.
