HOUSE BILL 1335

"AN ACT TO REPEAL ACT 746 OF 1983 [ARK. STAT. 78-1625 AND 1626]; TO PROVIDE THAT THE NORTHEAST ARKANSAS DISTRICT FAIR SHALL BE HELD IN JONESBORO THROUGH 1992; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Northeast Arkansas District Fair shall be held in Jonesboro, Arkansas through calendar year 1992, in all matters the Fair shall be subject to the rules and regulations of the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission and otherwise conducted in the same manner as other district fairs. For calendar year 1993 and thereafter, the location of the Northeast Arkansas District Fair shall be determined by the Northeast Arkansas District Fair Advisory Board under the provisions of Act 746 of 1983.

SECTION 2. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the present law relating to the Northeast Arkansas District Fair is unduly burdensome and in need of revision; that the revision should go into effect immediately; that unless this emergency clause is adopted this Act will not go into effect until ninety days after extended recess or adjournment of the General Assembly. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
