HOUSE BILL 1338

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT APPLICANTS FOR A MARRIAGE LICENSE SHALL PROVIDE EVIDENCE THAT THEY ARE NOT INFECTED WITH THE AIDS VIRUS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. No marriage license shall be issued in this State unless the applicants furnish proof to the person authorized to issue marriage licenses, under regulations promulgated by the State Health Department, that an examination of their blood within thirty days prior to the date of issuance of the license indicates that neither applicant is infected with the AIDS virus. The State Health Department shall promulgate such regulations as are necessary to implement this Act.

SECTION 2. Any person who issues a marriage license in violation of this Act shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
