HOUSE BILL 1350

"AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OR OFFER FOR SALE OF SPIRITUOUS,  
VINOUS OR MALT LIQUOR OR BEER FOR OFF PREMISES CONSUMPTION  
BETWEEN THE HOURS OF NINE P.M. AND SEVEN A.M.; TO REQUIRE  
EVERY ESTABLISHMENT COMMONLY KNOWN AS A PACKAGE STORE AND  
OPERATING UNDER A RETAILER'S PERMIT ISSUED BY THE ALCOHOLIC  
BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD OR THE DIRECTOR OF THE BOARD UNDER  
SECTION 6 OF ARTICLE 3 OF SECTION 108 OF 1935, TO CLOSE  
NIGHTLY AT NINE P.M.; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Hereafter, no spirituous, vinous or malt liquor or beer shall be sold or offered for sale for off premises consumption between the hours of nine p.m. and seven a.m. Every establishment operated under a retailer's permit issued by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board or the Director of the Board under the provisions of Section 6 of Article 3 of Act 108 of 1935 shall close at nine p.m.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
