HOUSE BILL 1404

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 7 OF ACT 898 OF 1981, THE SAME BEING
ARKANSAS STATUTES ANNOTATED SECTION 66-3507; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 7 of Act 898 of 1981, the same being Arkansas Statutes Annotated □66-3507, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 7. Group insurance offered to a resident of this State under a group policy issued to a group other than one described in Sections 2 through 6 shall be subject to the following requirements:

(A) No such group policy or certificate shall be delivered in this State unless the Commissioner finds that:

- (1) the issuance of the group policy is not contrary to the best interest of the public;
 - (2) the issuance of the group policy would be actuarially sound;
 - (3) the issuance of the group policy would result in economies of acquisition or administration; and
 - (4) the benefits are reasonable in relation to the premiums charged.
- (B) The premium for the policy shall be paid either from the policy-holder's funds or from funds contributed by the covered persons, or from both.
- (C) An insurer may exclude or limit the coverage on any person as to whom evidence of individual insurability is not satisfactory to the insurer.
- (D) The Commissioner may issue regulations implementing the requirements of subsection (A) of this Section."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
