HOUSE BILL 1406

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE SECRETARY-CASE COORDINATOR OF THE CHANCERY COURT OF THE EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT-EAST, AND TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE SECRETARY-CASE COORDINATOR OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT-EAST; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Chancery Court, Eighteenth Judicial Circuit-East, may employ a secretary-case coordinator to serve at the pleasure of the Judge, at an annual salary in the sum of Nineteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$19,500.00) during and for the calendar year of 1988 and each year thereafter, payable in equal monthly installments by Garland County.

SECTION 2. The Circuit Court, Eighteenth Judicial Circuit-East, may employ a secretary-case coordinator to serve at the pleasure of the Judge, at an annual salary in the sum of Nineteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$19,500.00) during and for the calendar year of 1988 and each year thereafter, payable in equal monthly installments by Garland County.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the salary now being paid to the secretary-case coordinator of the Chancery Court of the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit-East and the secretary-case coordinator of the Circuit Court of the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit-East is inadequate to compensate the secretary-case coordinators for the services performed and it is necessary to the proper administration of justice in said

Circuit that such salaries be increased commencing the calendar year of 1988. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
