"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS STATUTE 41-3151 TO ENHANCE THE PENALTY FOR A PERSON WHO UNLAWFULLY CARRIES A WEAPON INTO AN ESTABLISHMENT THAT SELLS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (4) of Section 1 of Act 696 of 1975, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statute 41-3151(4), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(4) Any person who carries a weapon into an establishment that sells alcoholic beverages shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not more than \$2,500.00 or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both. Otherwise, carrying a weapon is a class A misdemeanor."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
