"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - MANAGEMENT SERVICES DIVISION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1989; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - MANAGEMENT SERVICES DIVISION. There is hereby established for the Department of Finance and Administration -Management Services Division for the 1987-89 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. SECTION 19. The funds appropriated in Section 17 of this Act shall be used for matching funds for administering the Federal Grants provided in Section 18 of this Act. The Department of Finance and Administration -Management Services Division is hereby authorized to call upon all state agencies to assist in the implementation of the Drug Law Enforcement Program. In no event shall additional personnel be hired for the purpose of implementing the Drug Law Enforcement Program.

SECTION 20. CARRY FORWARD PROVISION. Any savings in the various classifications of Maintainence and Operation appropriations provided for the Management Services Division during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1988, will be carried forward for budget preparation required for presentation to the Arkansas Legislative Council. A like amount of funding will be carried forward in the appropriate fund account. A report of such balances carried forward will be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council.

SECTION 21. There is hereby established a method of recognition of service by employee of the State of Arkansas. The Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Personnel Management shall coordinate the purchase, distribution and presentation of said service awards based on years of service with the State of Arkansas for full time employees in all state agencies, boards, commissions, and others under the Governor's direction. Said awards shall be made upon attainment of 10, 20, and 30 years of service in state government. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall promulgate reasonable rules and regulations as he deems necessary in carrying out the provisions of this Service Recognition Program.

SECTION 22. The Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration, the Employment Security Division of the Department of Labor, the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville, the Arkansas Industrial Commission and any other state agency, board, commission, department, institution, college, university or authority, shall make data, information, statistics,or other records of information, available to the Department of Finance and Administration. Provided, however, that such information and/or records shall not identify persons, people, conglomerates, corporations, monopolies, or others that would, from any published data or data within the possession of the Director's Office of the Department of Finance and Administration, reveal the identity or any information or data of that particular identity that would be in conflict with federal laws.

SECTION 23. TRANSFER OF FUNDS. In the event that the Department of Finance and Administration determines that a savings can be effected by providing messenger service with state employees rather than under contract from a private vendor, the Department is hereby authorized to transfer from maintenance and operations to salaries and personal services matching the necessary appropriation authorized in this Act.

SECTION 24. LOANS TO MARKETING AND REDISTRIBUTION. In the event the monies available in the Property Sale Holding Fund are not adequate during any month of each year of the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 1989, to meet the payroll commitments of the Department of Finance and Administration -Management Services Division - Marketing and Redistribution, for Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching, as provided in Section 7 of this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State is hereby authorized to make loans, from time to time as needed, from the Budget Revolving Fund to the Property Sale Holding Fund to provide the monies required to meet the payroll and Personal Services Matching requirements for any such month. Provided that, if, at the end of each fiscal year, the Property Sale Holding Fund did not receive sufficient income to repay the entire amount of any such monies borrowed from the Budget Revolving Fund for the purposes, as authorized herein, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State is hereby authorized to transfer from the Constitutional and Fiscal Agencies Fund such amount as is necessary to reimburse the Budget Revolving Fund in behalf of loans made to the Property Sale Holding Fund to reimburse the Budget Revolving Fund for the amount of any such loan remaining unpaid at the end of each fiscal year.

SECTION 25. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 26. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 27. CONTRACT RESTRICTIONS. The agency, board, commission, department or institution to whom funds are appropriated by this Act shall not enter into any contract for any professional or consultant services which shall extend for more than twenty (20) actual working days or the total compensation exceeds five thousand dollars (\$5,000) during any one fiscal year without first seeking the advice of the Arkansas Legislative Council. Provided further, that all contracts for professional or consultant services shall be submitted monthly to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for reporting to the Legislative Council.

SECTION 28. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the

Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas

prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1987 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1987 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1987.
