HOUSE BILL1452

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE CITIES WITH POPULATION IN EXCESS OF 5,000  
TO MAKE MONTHLY PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS FOR EMPLOYEE ASSOCIATION  
DUES, GROUP INSURANCE, DEFERRED COMPENSATION AND CHARITIES;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Cities with a population in excess of 5,000 shall make monthly deductions from payrolls for all police officers and all firefighters for the following items: Deferred compensation under IRS code 457; the dues for Arkansas Municipal Police Association; The Fraternal Order of Police Lodges; Locals of International Association of Firefighters; Arkansas State Firefighters Association; any group insurance offered through an employee association, lodge, or union; any charity with an Arkansas office; any federal credit union.

SECTION 2. The city clerk, payroll officer or personnel director shall, upon written request, make deductions once a month for the items requested in this act, or any other deduction that is mutually agreed upon between the city and its police officers and firefighters, if the president or the secretary-treasurer of the employee association, lodge or union has furnished a written list of the employees and the desired deductions.
