HOUSE BILL 1457

"AN ACT TO REPEAL ACT 379 OF 1939 [ARK. STATS. 76-801 THROUGH 76-814] WHICH CREATED A COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMISSION IN EACH COUNTY OF THE STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that Act 379 of 1939 purported to create in each county of the State a county highway commission with the authority and responsibility of laying out, building, constructing, repairing and maintaining county roads in the county; that no such county highway commission is currently functioning in any county of the State; that Act 742 of 1977 which reorganized county government, specifically charged the county judge with the full responsibility for constructing, maintaining and operating a system of county roads, bridges and ferries in the county; that the provisions of Act 379 of 1939 providing for the creation of a county highway commission in each county is not currently followed and has in fact been superseded by the provisions of Act 742 of 1977 and therefore should be repealed.

SECTION 2. Act 379 of 1939, the same being Arkansas Statutes 76-801 through 76-814, is hereby repealed.
