HOUSE BILL 1517

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4 OF ACT 944 OF 1981 AS AMENDED, TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE CLERK-SECRETARY-CASE COORDINATOR FOR THE JUDGES OF THE EIGHTH CIRCUIT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of Act 944 of 1981, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. The salary and expenses to be paid to each clerk-secretary-case coordinator within the Eighth Circuit shall not be less than sixteen thousand four hundred twenty dollars (\$16,420.00) per year nor more than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) per year."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the compensation currently provided for the clerk-secretary-case coordinator for the Eighth Circuit is inadequate to properly compensate the person serving in such position; that it is essential to the effective and efficient administration of justice in the Eighth Circuit that the compensation provided for this position be increased at the earliest possible date. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
