HOUSE B1521

"AN ACT TO PROHIBIT PRIVATE CLUBS FROM BEING ESTABLISHED IN HOTELS AND RESTAURANTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISPENSING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The establishment of private clubs in hotels and restaurants for the purpose of dispensing alcoholic beverages is prohibited.

SECTION 2. Any private club license issued to a hotel or restaurant prior to the passage of this Act shall be revoked within 60 days of its passage.

SECTION 3. Any hotel or restaurant which establishes a private club in violation of this Act shall forfeit its right to do business in this State and shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$10,000 for each day it is in violation of this Act.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
