HOUSE BILL 1522

"AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 10 OF ACT 132 OF 1969, AS AMENDED,
WHICH AUTHORIZED THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD TO
GRANT PERMITS TO PRIVATE CLUBS; TO PROHIBIT PRIVATE CLUBS
FROM DISPENSING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AFTER THE EFFECTIVE
DATE OF THIS ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall grant no permit to private clubs after the effective date of this Act, and all permits previously granted shall expire on the effective date of this Act. Furthermore no private club shall dispense or possess alcoholic beverages after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 2. The owners, operators, employees and patrons of private clubs who violate this Act shall be deemed guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of no more than \$5,000.00 and imprisoned for no more than two years, or both.

SECTION 3. Section 10 of Act 132 of 1969, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statute 48-1410, is hereby repealed.
