HOUSE BILL 1529

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS STATUTE 3-1104 TO PROHIBIT PERSONS
FROM ELECTIONEERING WITHIN 500 FEET OF POLLING PLACES ON
ELECTION DAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (k) of Section 4 of Article 11 of Act 465 of 1969, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statute 3-1104(k), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(k) No officer of election shall do any electioneering on any election day. No person shall hand out or distribute or offer to hand out or distribute any campaign literature or any literature regarding any candidate or issue on the ballot, to solicit signatures on any petition, to solicit contributions for any charitable or other purpose, to do any electioneering of any kind whatsoever within five hundred (500) feet of any polling place on election day."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
