HOUSE BILL 1537

"AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HOTEL AND RESTAURANT PRIVATE CLUBS FROM POSSESSING OR DISPENSING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN AREAS IN WHICH THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION IS UNLAWFUL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall not, after the effective date of this Act, issue a private club permit for the establishment of a private club which occupies space in a hotel or restaurant located in an area in which the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption is unlawful.

SECTION 2. All private club permits issued by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board prior to the effective date of this Act for private clubs which occupy space in a hotel or restaurant located in areas wherein the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption is unlawful, shall expire sixty calendar days after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. Any person who operates a private club in violation of this Act shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$1,000 for each day of the violation.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
