HOUSE BILL 1552

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4 OF ACT 491 OF 1921 AS AMENDED,  
[ARK. STAT. 19-2204], AND SECTION 1 OF ACT 462 OF 1983, AS  
AMENDED [ARK. STAT. 19-1829], TO INCREASE RETIREMENT BENEFITS  
FOR RETIRANTS OF A LOCAL FIRE OR POLICE PENSION FUND; AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of 491 of 1921, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statute 19-2204, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 4. (a) (1) Any pension fund member who has served in a fire department in the State of Arkansas for a period of twenty (20) years or more, the last five years of which shall have been consecutive, shall be entitled to be retired and receive from the fund a monthly pension equal to one-half (1/2) of the salary attached to the rank he held as a volunteer, part-paid or full-paid member.

(2) The term salary shall mean recurring pays which are received for the fireman's regularly scheduled work week and shall not include payments for unused accrued sick leave or annual leave, or the cash value of any non-recurring or unusual remunerations.

(3) Any fireman who shall have completed the period of service as provided for in this section shall receive from the Board a certificate showing that he has completed the term of service required and is entitled to participate in all the benefits provided for in this Act upon compliance with and subject to all the other terms and conditions herein, whether he sever his connections or continue in service at the expiration of the time as set out above, and the right to participate in the fund shall become a vested right and shall not be lost by the termination of his services with or without cause.

(b) Any full-paid fireman who is already retired or who will retire in the future shall not receive less than \$250 per month. Any volunteer fireman who is already retired or who will retire in the future shall not receive less than \$30 per month.

(c) (1) Any full-paid fireman who has more than twenty (20) years of service at the time of retirement shall be entitled to receive the equivalent of 1.25 percent of his/her salary in addition to one-half (1/2) of the salary attached to his/her rank for each full year worked over and above twenty (20) years, but in no instance shall he receive more than 75 percent of salary.

(2) The increase in benefit levels provided in this subsection for service beyond twenty (20) years shall apply only to those firemen who retire on or after January 1, 1987.

(d) A volunteer or part-paid fireman who becomes a full-paid member of his fire department shall be eligible to retire as a full-paid member only if he shall have been employed as a full-paid member for a period of at least five (5) years immediately prior to his retirement."

SECTION 2. Subsection (b) of Section 9 of Act 250 of 1937, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statute 19-1809(b), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(b) (1) Any policeman who has more than twenty (20) years of service at time of retirement shall be entitled to receive the equivalent of 1.25 percent of salary in addition to one-half (1/2) of salary for each full year worked over and above twenty (20) years, but in no instance shall he receive more than 75 percent of salary.

(2) The increase in benefit levels provided in this subsection for service beyond twenty (20) years shall apply only to those policemen who retire on or after January 1, 1987."

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
