"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ACT 368 OF 1977, THE SAME
BEING ARKANSAS STATUTES ANNOTATED SECTION 66-5402; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act 368 of 1977, the same being Arkansas Statutes 66-5402, is hereby amended by adding Subsection (6) as follows:

"(6) Any person who is exempt from the provisions of this Act pursuant to Subsection (3) (c) (ii) of this Section shall, prior to administering a legal referral services program in this State or prior to enrollment of members in such a program in this State, file program materials and documents with the Commissioner to support such program's exempt status under this Act. Subsequent to the Commissioner's approval of the exemption of such program from the provisions of this Act, such person shall promptly file documents referencing any modifications or changes in such program for the Commissioner's review and determination as to whether the program as modified is exempt from the provisions of this Act."

SECTION 2. Section 12 of Act 368 of 1977, the same being Arkansas Statute 66-5412, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Agents shall be licensed in accordance with such provisions as the Commissioner in his discretion deems applicable under Sections 144 through 180 of Act 148 of 1959, as amended. The Commissioner may develop and administer to license applicants such examination as he deems appropriate."

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
