HOUSE BILL 1582

"AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (d) OF SECTION 11 OF ACT 34 OF THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF 1983 [ARK. STAT. 80-850.20(d)], CLARIFYING THE REQUIRED AMOUNT TO BE PAID CERTIFIED PERSONNEL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (d) of Section 11 of Act 34 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1983, the same being Arkansas Statute 80-850.20(d), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(d) In school year 1985-86 and each school year thereafter, each district in the State shall pay its certified personnel an amount equal to at least seventy percent (70%) of its net current revenue. In such years, not less than eighty percent (80%) of seventy percent (70%) of each school district's increase in net current revenue over the net current revenue received the previous school year less the total salary expenditure required to fund additional certified personnel added to the staff of the district in such school year shall be divided equally among the certified personnel positions existing in the district in such year unless the board of directors of the district and a majority of the teachers agree to a different distribution. Provided, however, in any fiscal year following a year in which a reduction in State Minimum Foundation Program Aid was imposed after the year began, the certified personnel salary fund requirements of this Act shall be reduced by deducting the total amount of funds other than Minimum Foundation Program Aid that were expended the previous year to compensate for the reduction in Minimum Foundation Program Aid in order to meet certified personnel salary fund requirements of this Act based on the projected amount of Minimum Foundation Program Aid certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State at the time of entering into certified personnel salary contracts of said pre-

vious year. The district shall file with the State Board of Education annually a salary schedule for its certified employees which recognizes as a minimum training and experience. This schedule shall reflect the actual pay practices of the district, including all fringe benefits."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
