HOUSE BILL 1595

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE STATE AGENCIES TO IMPLEMENT A SMOKING
POLICY FOR THEIR GENERAL OFFICE SPACE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. For the purposes of this Act:

(a) "State agency" means any department, agency, board, commission, office or other authority of the State.

(b) "Smoking" means a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other lit tobacco product.

(c) "General office space" means space occupied by personnel performing their daily work functions.

SECTION 2. The chief administrative officer of each State agency shall promulgate a smoking policy for the general office space of the State agency. The policy shall take into consideration the rights of both non-smokers and smokers. The smoking policy for each State agency shall be implemented by September 1, 1987.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
