HOUSE BILL 1597

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE QUORUM COURT OF COUNTIES HAVING A POPULATION OF BETWEEN TWENTY THOUSAND AND TWENTY-ONE THOUSAND ACCORDING TO THE 1980 FEDERAL CENSUS TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL COURT COST NOT TO EXCEED FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) ON ALL CIVIL CASES FILED IN ALL COURTS WITHIN SAID COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The quorum court of any county having a population of no less than twenty thousand (20,000) inhabitants nor more than twenty-one thousand (21,000) inhabitants according to the 1980 Federal Census of the population is hereby authorized to levy an additional court cost not to exceed five dollars (\$5.00) on each and every civil case filed in any court within said county, provided that the levy of such additional court costs is approved by the governing body of the largest first class city within said county. The funds derived from the additional court costs shall be deposited in the county treasury and shall be used exclusively for the operation of a juvenile/probation office including the salary of a juvenile officer or a probation officer or both.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
