HOUSE BILL 1603

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE HOTELS AND RESTAURANTS LOCATED IN AREAS WHERE THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION IS LAWFUL TO OPERATE AS PRIVATE CLUBS ON SUNDAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, hotels and restaurants which are not private clubs and which are located in areas wherein the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption is lawful, may operate as a private club on Sunday only, provided that they comply with all provisions of the private club law which are not in conflict with the purposes and intent of this Act.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
