HOUSE BILL 1623

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 7 OF ACT 465 OF 1977 [ARK. STAT.
75-1057.6] TO PROVIDE FOR A FEE OF TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) FOR A
DRIVER'S RECORD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 7 of Act 465 of 1977, the same being Arkansas Statutes 75-1057.6, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) The Office of Driver Services may report a driver's record, without charge, to all courts, law enforcement agencies and governmental agencies as provided herein. A fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) may be charged for any record search made and reported to the driver on whom the record is compiled or any other individual or organization requesting said record.

(b) Where a release has been granted by a driver or his legally appointed representative and such release has not been withdrawn as provided for in Section 6, then all subsequent reports made on such driver shall be subject to the fee in effect at the time such subsequent report is made.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
