HOUSE BILL 1656

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4 OF ACT 972 OF 1985 [ARK. STAT. 75-1714.1], TO REQUIRE THAT APPLICANTS FOR MOTORIZED BICYCLE CERTIFICATES PASS A ROAD TEST; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of Act 972 of 1985, the same being Arkansas Statute 75-1714.1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motorized bicycle upon a public street or highway within this State unless such person has a certificate to operate such vehicle. Any person who has a motor-driven-cycle license or motorcycle license or an operator or chauffeur license shall qualify to operate a motorized bicycle and is not required to obtain a certificate from the State Police for the operation of a motorized bicycle. All motorized bicycle certificates shall be issued by the State Police and no certificate shall be issued to a person under ten (10) years of age. Prior to being issued a certificate to operate a motorized bicycle, the applicant shall take and pass an examination pertaining to the rules of the road, a vision test and a road test. The State Police shall charge a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) for each certificate issued and the proceeds from such fees shall be deposited in the State Treasury as special revenues and credited to the State Police Fund."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
