HOUSE BILL 1689

"AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF SPOTLIGHTS FROM PUBLIC ROADS,
STREETS AND HIGHWAYS; TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS; TO PRESCRIBE THE
PENALTY THEREFOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) It shall be unlawful to use a spotlight from any
public road, street or highway except for:

(1) use by a law enforcement officer, game and fish officer,
emergency service worker or utility company employee in the performance of
their duties;

(2) use by a person or his employee to examine real or personal
property or livestock owned or rented by the person; or

(3) use by a person to assist in the repair or removal of a
motor vehicle or other property.

(b) This act shall not apply within the boundaries of a city of the
first class or a city of the second class.

(c) A violation of this Act shall be a class C misdemeanor, as defined
by Act 280 of 1975, as amended.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
hereby repealed.
