HOUSE BILL 1695

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE OFFICERS OF THE STATE CAPITOL POLICE TO
SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THE COURSE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING
AT THE ARKANSAS LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING ACADEMY; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. All members of the State Capitol Police employed on the effective date of this Act shall satisfactorily complete the training course at the Law Enforcement Training Academy within twelve (12) months of the effective date of this Act and all members of the State Capitol Police hereafter employed shall satisfactorily complete the training course for law enforcement officers at the Law Enforcement Training Academy within twelve (12) months of their hire date.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
