HOUSE BILL 1753

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS STATUTE 75-201 TO EXEMPT MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS LICENSED BY THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION FROM THE REQUIREMENT OF CERTIFICATION BY THE COUNTY SHERIFF OR CHIEF OF POLICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The second paragraph of subsection F of Section 24 of Act 65 of 1929, as amended, the same being the second paragraph of Arkansas Statute 75-201 (F), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"As a condition precedent to obtaining dealer's motor vehicle license plates, the dealers shall furnish the Commissioner of Revenues a certification by the sheriff of the county in which the applicant's business is located, or if located within a first class city, a certification by an officer of the metropolitan police department that the applicant is a new car franchise dealer or a used car dealer and has a bona fide established place of business used exclusively for the sale of new and/or used motor vehicles, an office used exclusively for such business, a telephone listed in the name of the business, a sign identifying the establishment as a new car franchise dealership or a used car dealership. Such certification shall be required for all renewals of dealer motor vehicle license plates. This motor vehicle dealer certification shall not apply to those dealers who are licensed by the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission and who are regulated by that authority."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
