HOUSE BILL 1762

"AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (i) OF SECTION 22 OF ACT 397 OF 1955, AS AMENDED [ARK. STAT. 73-1775(i)] RELATING TO THE DISTRIBUTION OF FORFEITED BONDS AND FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR CARRIER ACT, 1955; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (i) of Section 22 of Act 397 of 1955, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statutes 73-1775(i), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(i) All forfeited bonds and fines assessed by any court or justice of the peace for violations of this Act shall be remitted by the court, or the clerk thereof, or by the justice of the peace, or collecting officer, to the Commission to be deposited in the State Treasury. One-half (1/2) of the amount shall be credited to the General Revenue Fund Account of the State Apportionment Fund and one-half shall be credited to the County Aid Fund as special revenues and the State Treasurer shall distribute an equal amount of the revenues to each county in the State."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts or laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
