HOUSE BILL 1824

"AN ACT TO AMEND ITEMS 15, 16 AND 23 OF SECTION 1 OF ACT 6 OF 1987; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Items 15, 16 and 23 of Section 1 of Act 6 of 1987 are hereby amended to read as follows:

"(15) SALARIES OF THIRTEEN PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS -		
DIV. A OF \$55,831 EACH PER YEAR	\$ 725,803	\$ 725,803
"(16) SALARIES OF ELEVEN PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS -		
DIV. B OF \$46,465 EACH PER YEAR	511,115	511,115
"(23) PERSONAL SERVICES MATCHING	1,688,016	1,688,016"

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1987 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1987 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1987.
