HOUSE BILL 1878

"AN ACT TO ALLOW STANDARDIZED MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT FOR
MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Official members of the various Boards and Commissions of the State of Arkansas are hereby authorized to receive mileage reimbursement for travel expense incurred while performing official duties of such Boards and Commissions of the State of Arkansas in an amount not to exceed that which is authorized by law as the maximum allowable mileage reimbursement for State employees at the time said travel is incurred by the various Board and Commission member(s).

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that because of the case *Ricarte v. State*, CR 86-31, a question has arisen over the validity of Act 1035 of the Extended Session of 1976; that this Act is a reenactment of the former law; and that the immediate passage of this Act is necessary to clarify the state of the law on this issue. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
