HOUSE BILL 1970

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL BEER WHICH CONTAINS ALCOHOL AND WHICH IS SOLD IN CONTAINERS TO HAVE A NOTICE PRINTED ON THE CONTAINER THAT THE BEER CONTAINS ALCOHOL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. No beer containing alcohol shall be sold in this State in any container which does not bear a label indicating that the beer contains alcohol. All beer sold or offered for sale in violation of this Act shall be subject to forfeiture and disposal in the same manner provided by law for the forfeiture and disposal of controlled substances.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
