HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING STATE BUILDING SERVICES TO RENEGOTIATE ALL STATE  
LEASES OF PRIVATELY OWNED PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, it appears that there is an abundance of unrented office space in Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the State pays a substantial amount of tax money to the private sector for the rental of office space; and

WHEREAS, in light of the glut of unrented office space available, it is obviously wise to renegotiate State agency leases in order to take advantage of market conditions which are favorable to the State; and

WHEREAS, State Building Services has the responsibility for leasing office space for State agencies,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That State Building Services is hereby requested to renegotiate all State leases for rented office space.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this resolution the Chief Clerk of the House shall transmit a copy hereof to the Director of State Building Services.
