HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO PERMIT THE INTRODUCTION OF A BILL PERTAINING TO RETIREMENT
BENEFITS FOR AN ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICIAL.

WHEREAS, Section 9(B)(4) of Act 90 of 1973, as amended (Ark. Stat. 4-151), provides that no retirement bill may be introduced after the first thirty (30) calendar days of a regular biennial session of the General Assembly except upon approval by a vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the full membership of each house of the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the first thirty (30) calendar days of the Seventy-Sixth (76th) General Assembly having expired,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That Representative Sturgis Miller is hereby granted leave to introduce a bill relating to the purchase of retirement benefits by a qualifying elected public official prior to January 1, 1988.
