

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO PERMIT THE INTRODUCTION OF A BILL PERTAINING TO RETIREMENT
BENEFITS FOR THE WIDOW OF A MUNICIPAL JUDGE AND A RETIRED
MUNICIPAL COURT CLERK.

WHEREAS, Section 9(B)(4) of Act 90 of 1973, as amended, [Ark. Stat. 4-151] provides that no retirement bill may be introduced after the first thirty (30) calendar days of a regular biennial session of the General Assembly except upon approval by a vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the full membership of each house of the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the first thirty (30) calendar days of the Seventy-Sixth (76th) General Assembly having expired,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That Representative Jim Stockley is hereby granted leave to introduce a bill relating to the retirement benefits for widows of municipal judges and retired municipal court clerks.
