HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

NAMING THE LAKE FORMED BY THE FELSENTHAL LOCK AND DAM "LAKE JACK LEE" AND NAMING THE CALION LOCK AND DAM "H. K. THATCHER LOCK AND DAM".

WHEREAS, the Felsenthal National Wildlife Refuge and the 9 foot navigation channel on the Arkansas part of the Ouachita-Black Rivers are and will continue to be of tremendous social and economic benefit to the citizens of Union County and the State of Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, without the efforts of J. L. "Jack" Lee and H. K. Thatcher said National Wildlife Refuge and navigation channel would never have come into existence; and

WHEREAS, the lake formed by the Felsenthal Lock and Dam is not presently named; and

WHEREAS, the Calion Lock and Dam site presently has no other designation;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the lake formed by the Felsenthal Lock and Dam be named Lake Jack Lee and the Calion Lock and Dam be named the H. K. Thatcher Lock and Dam.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Arkansas Congressional Delegation, the U. S. Corps of Engineers, and the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service.
