

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
AND SENATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERMITTING THE INTRODUCTION OF  
A HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR A STUDY OF THE  
CURRENT LAWS AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING TEACHER CERTIFICATION  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE FEASIBILITY OF  
ESTABLISHING ALTERNATIVE REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCH CERTIFICATION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL  
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

The Joint Rules of the House of Representatives and Senate are hereby  
suspended for the purpose of permitting the introduction of a House Concurrent  
Resolution to provide for a study of the current laws and regulations con-  
cerning teacher certification for the purpose of determining the feasibility  
of establishing alternative requirements for such certification.
