HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROVIDING FOR A SUSPENSION OF THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE TO PERMIT THE INTRODUCTION OF A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING A STUDY OF THE NEED TO MODIFY AND STREAMLINE THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM OF THIS STATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Joint Rules of the House of Representatives and the Senate are hereby suspended for the purpose of authorizing the introduction of a Concurrent Resolution providing for a study of the need to modify and streamline the judicial system of this State.
