HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

FOR SUSPENSION OF THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE TO PERMIT THE INTRODUCTION AND CONSIDERATION OF A BILL TO ESTABLISH LEGISLATIVE INTENT WITH RESPECT TO ANY ENACTMENT RESULTING FROM THE PASAGE OF HOUSE BILLS 1874 THROUGH 1938 OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Joint Rules of the House of Representatives and Senate are hereby suspended for the purpose of permitting the introduction and consideration of a bill to establish legislative intent with respect to any enactment resulting from the passage of House Bills 1874 through 1938 of the regular session of the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly.
